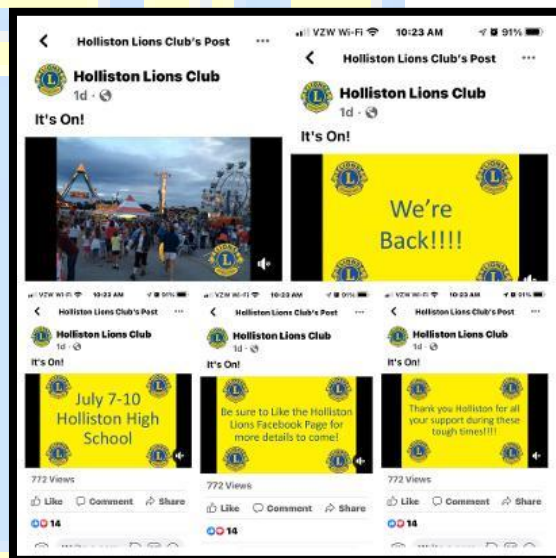
## HLC PRESIDENT DECLARES “THE CARNIVAL IS ON!!!”

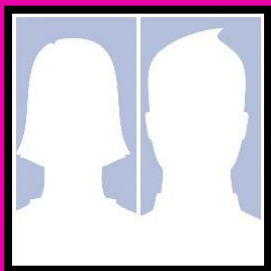
